Conflict – stabilisation – assimilation? The consequences of migration in the life of the inhabitants of Lower Silesia after 1945. A comparative approach

international scientific conference

§ 1 General

1. The *Conflict – stabilisation – assimilation? The consequences of migration in the life of the inhabitants of Lower Silesia after 1945. A comparative approach* international scientific conference (hereinafter referred to as the Conference) is organised by the “Remembrance and Future” Centre, together with the University of Wrocław and the Institute of National Remembrance - Commission for the Prosecution of Crimes against the Polish Nation, Wrocław Branch. These institutions are hereinafter referred to as Organisers.
2. The Conference will be held on the premises of the Depot History Centre in Wrocław, at Grabiszyńska 184 on 28 and 29 September 2021. The detailed agenda of the Conference has been published on the website of one of the organisers: www.zajezdnia.org.
3. These regulations specify the rules of participation in the Conference.

§ 2 General provisions

1. The Conference is held in both Polish and English. The Conference Organisers will provide simultaneous interpretation from English into Polish and from Polish into English.
2. The Conference will be streamed live and posted on the streaming channel of one of the organisers.
3. The Conference will be divided into several thematic sessions, established by the Conference Organisers.
4. Participation in the Conference is free of charge.

§ 3 Conditions of participation

1. The Organisers offer two ways of participation:
 - a. Active
 - b. Passive
2. Active participation entails presenting a paper outlining scientific research results during the Conference. Active participants include individuals who have submitted their application form by the deadline specified by the Organisers and confirmed their participation in the event.
3. Passive participants attend the event as the audience. This type of participation does not require prior notification or confirmation of attendance to the Organisers.

§ 3 Regulations relating to the ongoing epidemic

1. Each Conference participant submits a Health Declaration, in which they declare that to the best to their knowledge, they are not infected with COVID-19, in quarantine or

under epidemiological surveillance. The Declaration form, the model of which constitutes an appendix to these Regulations, will be presented to participants for signature prior to the Conference.

2. The declaration referred to in item 1 will be handed over to the competent sanitary authorities upon their request to carry out epidemiological investigation in the case of infection or detection of being in direct contact with an infected person, in accordance with the current legislation on prevention, and control of COVID-19.
3. The Organisers assure that during the Conference, all the laws and sanitary guidelines aimed at ensuring epidemiological safety of the Conference participants will be respected and in place; therefore, the Organisers reserve the right to introduce specific rules of participation, such as covering the mouth and nose, hand disinfection, observing social distancing rules, etc.
4. The Organisers reserve the right to introduce limits on the number of participants in the Conference due to restrictions imposed by law and sanitary guidelines in force as a result of the ongoing epidemic.
5. Conference participants, who are holders of a COVID-19 vaccination certificate will not be counted against the applicable quotas, which is why the Organisers encourage participants to produce their vaccination certificates, which will be inspected by a designated staff member delegated by the Organisers. Producing vaccination certificates will enable increasing the number of Conference participants.

§ 4 Personal data protection

1. Personal data provided by participants of the Conference in relation to submitting the Declaration referred to in § 3, item 1, will be processed by the Controller – the “Remembrance and Future” Centre in Wrocław, Grabiszyńska 184, 53-235, e-mail address: sekretariat@zajezdnia.org, phone number: (+48) 71 715 96 00.
2. The Controller will comply with the obligation to provide information, which stems from the Regulation (EU) of the European Parliament and of the Council 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (GDPR), by including a relevant information clause in the declaration form.

§ 5 Final provisions

1. Participation in the Conference implies acceptance of the provisions of these regulations.
2. The Organisers reserve the right to change the regulations; any change to the regulations will be published in the manner specified for the regulations.
3. The regulations shall enter into force on the date of their publication on the Organiser’s website – www.zajezdnia.org.
